Maria started her manual practice in 2003 when she was a student at Pharmacy school at the State University. She suffered a sports injury and received rehabilitation at the University hospital. She was amazed by the healing process and later finished massage school courses to work at the Center of physical therapy and rehabilitation. She finished advanced courses in medical massage when she graduated from Pharmacy school in 2005. She was looking for a more efficient and faster way to help patients heal and recover. She believed in the principles of osteopathy that the body has self-correcting mechanisms to heal itself. She continued practicing and studying medical massage for nurses as well as post graduate seminars in Rehabilitation, Meridian Therapy, Applied Kinesiology, Visceral therapy, Exercise Therapy, and Introduction to Osteopathy in Russia. Maria was granted a scholarship at Yale University as a post graduate fellow in Public Health and Epidemiology. While there she was introduced to Upledger and Barral Institute and their directors in the USA in 2008-2009.
